Fee: \$15 each to cover campsite permits. Tents, sleeping pads, sleeping bags, stoves and cook sets available to rent* for a separate nominal \$5 fee.

*If you are renting equipment, you will need to meet the Camping Gear Volunteer at **the White Oak Parking Lot on 7/6/24 at 4PM.**
