### 1. NON-RESOLUTION BOARD ITEMS

President Scott Savage called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m.

Mr. Savage did a role call for all Board of Park Commissioners.

Mr. Savage led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Savage shared that he had guests from out of town who visited at least 7-8 parks across the district and were completely amazed with the beauty of Metroparks Toledo. He acknowledged the hard work that the staff does on a daily basis to make the parks so amazing.

Mr. Fritz Byers also shared that he just returned from a visit with his daughter, and she observed just how state-of-the-art Metroparks Toledo truly is. Additionally, she shared that she is so struck by Metroparks Toledo's

capabilities in all of its conservation efforts.

Mr. Savage noted that the Vision Statement will be included with the agenda and meeting minutes moving forward to direct focus toward Metroparks' vision for Board meetings and throughout the park district.

### 2. CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

Mr. Fritz Byers made a motion to approve the consent agenda and for the disposition of the minutes for the regular Board meeting held on May 26, 2021. This motion was seconded by Ms. Lera Doneghy and approved.

### 3. CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS FROM DIRECTOR AND EMPLOYEES OF THE PARK DISTRICT FOR REVIEW

A. Treasurer's Report - Matt Cleland, Chief Financial Officer/Treasurer and Wendy Garczynski, Comptroller

Ms. Wendy Garczynski shared that everything is running as expected. She noted that fringe benefits are running below month-to-date budget because the health benefits payment posted in early June rather than the more typical posting in late May. Mr. Byers inquired why the utilities are running low compared to the month-to-date budget. Ms. Garczynski stated that she was not sure why, but will look into it. She observed that it might be that Metroparks Toledo is just returning to running full capacity regarding rentals whereas earlier in the year, facility rentals were very low. Mr. Matt Cleland also noted that fuel costs were low at the beginning of the year as well.

### 4. BOARD APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS, DEEDS, AGREEMENTS, ETC.

A. Mrs. Doneghy offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

#### Resolution No. 52-21 – Ratification of Schedule of Payables

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

B. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 53-21 – Approval of Supplement and Amendment of the 2021 Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations Measure

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

Mr. Savage reported that at the Mercy Gift Announcement last week Mr. Bob Baxter spoke about the Metroparks Toledo park district and how the park district's mission and vision align with Mercy's. At the celebration, Mr. Baxter said: "Vision without execution is a hallucination and execution without vision is a nightmare." Mr. Baxter observed that he learned from the Cannaley Treehouse Village that Metroparks Toledo has a vision that is capable of being executed.

C. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

### Resolution No. 54-21 – Transfers from General Fund to Capital Construction and Education Funds

Mr. Cleland reported that an example of these transferred funds would be for upkeep to the Cannaley Treehouse Village.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

D. Mrs. Doneghy offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 55-21 – Contract Approval, Municipal Advisor Services

Mr. Cleland reported that due to the nature of the project, it is very important to have someone skilled within the bond space to help develop the best plan specific to Glass City Riverwalk. Mr. Byers shared that members of the Board of Park Commissioners have always admired solid capabilities within the finance area, and now moving into more sophistication within Metroparks Toledo's finance model, he commends Mr. Cleland for reaching out in this space. This is a clear illustration that Metroparks Toledo is indeed a standout park district in the nation. Mr. Savage is familiar with the firm and stated it is highly respected in the field. Mr. Cleland reported that the timeline for this process is to seek answers fairly quickly, as soon as July or August 2021, with a potential need to perform a bridge in the fall.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

E. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 56-21 – Amendment to Resolution No. 89-20, "Authorization to Engage the Law Firm Spengler Nathanson P.L.L. for Legal Services"

Mr. Cleland reported that due to the number of engagements with Spengler Nathanson P.L.L. for legal services there is a need to increase the purchase order amount. Ms. Luetke inquired if this will cover costs for the remainder of the year. Mr. Cleland reported that it should, but if the need arises, we will return to the Board for an additional amendment. Mr. Byers stated that he is very pleased with the services Spengler Nathanson P.L.L offers and feels the pricing is very reasonable.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

F. Mrs. Doneghy offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 57-21 – Authorization to Request Funding through the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service

Mr. Allen Gallant reported that this funding will go toward the Glass City Riverwalk that will run behind the docks down to the Anthony Wayne Bridge.

Mr. Savage reported that often once resolutions are passed, the actual work that transpires behind the scenes is unnoticed, when actually Metroparks Toledo's staff is working tirelessly to continue breaking down barriers and providing additional opportunities to the park district's communities.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

G. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 58-21 – Authorization for the Design, Fabrication, and Supply of Customized Play Equipment for Glass City Metropark

Mr. Joe Fausnaugh reported that this play structure is customized, does not match any other type of play area that exists, and will be a regional draw to Glass City Metropark.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

Ms. Doneghy reported that on July 14, 2021, she and Ms. Luetke will be hosting a speaker's panel titled "Breaking Barriers." Five different women will participate on the panel to share their various experiences at this free event at Brookwood Area. Each of the women will then offer a follow-up event based on the interest.

With no further business or action to be taken, Mrs. Doneghy made a motion to adjourn the Board meeting at 10:04 a.m., which was seconded by Mr. Byers and approved.

### 1. Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – General Fund as of 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of the General Fund budgeted revenues, expenditures and transfers compared to actual revenues, expenditures and transfers by month as well as year-end. The approved 2021 general operating fund budget and actual cash basis revenues, expenditures and transfers are represented. Year to date budget distribution is based upon a 12 month proration with the exception of salaries and fringe benefits. Salary and fringe benefit budget distribution is based upon a proration of 26 pay dates. (See Appended Statement – Attachment A).

<u>Current State</u>: Property tax revenue for the first half is below projections. This shortfall has been confirmed with the Lucas County Auditor's Office and is attributed to collections falling short, likely related to the pandemic. Charges for Service and Fees is trending well above projection as reservations have resumed and are "re-filling the pipeline". Year to date fringe benefits expense is understated this month because the health insurance payment did not post until early July.

### 2. Receipts, Disbursements and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – All Funds as of 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of annual budgeted receipts and disbursements compared to cash basis actuals as of month end. The General, Education/Programming and Capital Construction funds are presented as individual columns. The "Grant Funds", "Land Acquisition/Development" and "All Other Funds" columns are each summaries of multiple funds. The far right column is a total of all funds. General fund budget and actual numbers presented in this report are consistent with those presented in the report listed above. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment B).

<u>Current State</u>: Revenues and expenditures are within expectations on the All Funds BVA report. Land acquisition related expenses exceed 2021 budget amounts because of payments made for prior year encumbrances.

### 3. Fund Advances Report – All Funds as of 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: This is a report of inter-fund, Board approved advances activity. Advances are made to support reimbursement grants and activities that would otherwise result in negative fund balances. Advances are returned or when reimbursements are received.

### 5. Credit Card Account Review as of 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: Per Ohio Revised Code 1545.072 the credit card compliance officer must review the number of cards and accounts issued, the number of active cards and accounts issued, the cards' and accounts' expiration dates, and the cards' and accounts' credit limits and report this information to the board at least quarterly. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment C)

<u>Current State</u>: Josh Brenwell, Credit Card Compliance Officer, has reviewed the attached report and compared it with credit card statements to confirm the accuracy of information provided.

No rewards have been received based on the use of the park district's credit card account for 2021.

### 6. Investment Ledger as of 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: This report is a listing of the Park District's current investment holdings. Current investments are allowable per the Ohio Revised Code and are laddered over a 5-year period. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment D).

<u>Current State</u>: One certificate of deposit with UBS was called in June, proceeds were invested in short term commercial paper. Reinvestment of maturities continue to be focused on short term commercial paper in anticipation of upcoming needs.

In June, an additional STAR Ohio account was established to support Ohio Damn Safety's requirement for surety associated with the Howard Marsh Phase II.

### 7. Then and Now Report for the month ended 06/30/2021

<u>Description</u>: The Ohio Revised Code (ORC) requires fiscal certification indicating that amounts required for purchases, obligations, contracts, etc. have been lawfully appropriated and are in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances. Then and now is a certification by the Board that funds were available when an obligation was made (then) and at the time of certification (now) for obligations made prior to certification. (See Appended Statement – Attachments E).

<u>Current State</u>: There are three items requiring certification by the board on the Then and Now Report for the month of June.

The Transportation Alternatives Program may provide up to 80% of the construction or implementation cost of a project. The applicant is required to provide a local cash match that is a minimum of 20% of the construction or implementation cost.

This project includes three separate applications for different portions on the North Fork of the Wabash Cannonball Trail. The first is from SR 295 to Waterville Monclova Road (4.77 miles). The second is from Waterville Monclova Road to Jerome Road (1.72 miles). The third is from the Fulton-Lucas Road to SR 295 (2.99 miles). Metroparks and Lucas County will share the local cash match requirement.

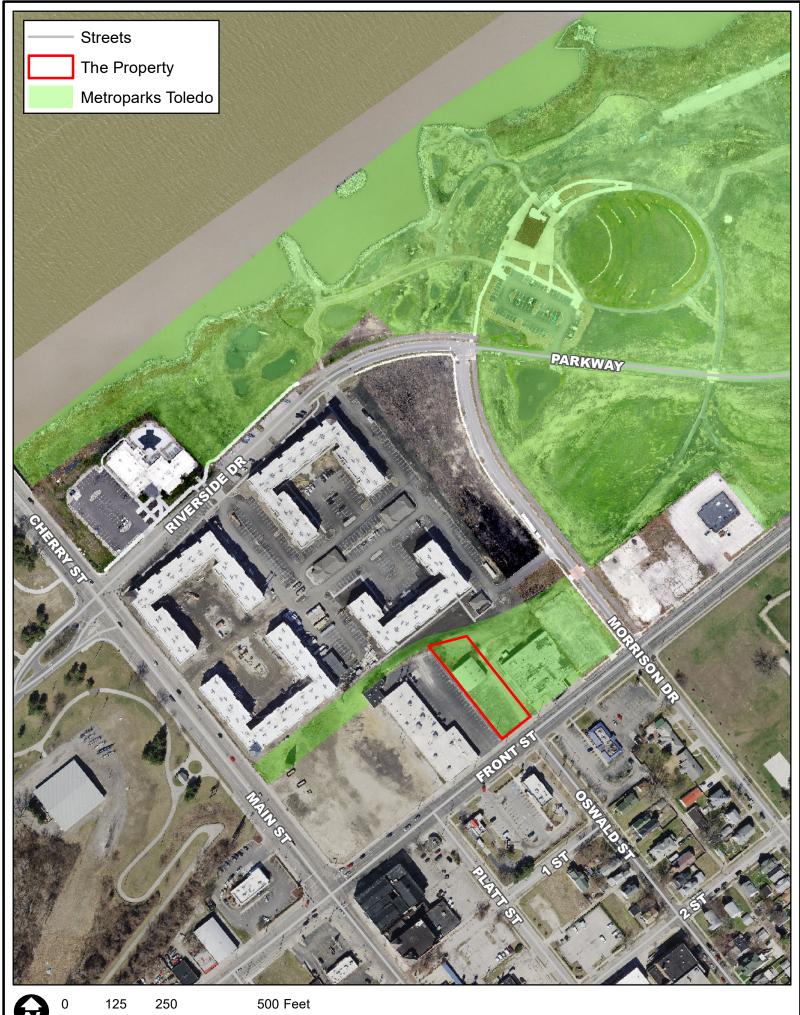

### **DESCRIPTION:**

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is designing and planning a state highway improvement project identified as LUC 120/Section 11.32, PID 102940, involving the replacement of the Central Avenue Bridge across the Ottawa River (the Project) located adjacent to Wildwood Preserve Metropark (Wildwood).

In order to construct the Project, it is necessary that ODOT acquire an additional right-of-way over a portion of Wildwood adjacent to Central Avenue, including a 0.311-acre permanent highway easement and a 0.006-acre temporary construction easement. In total, 0.068 acres of parkland within the permanent easement area will be permanently converted for highway purposes as necessary to complete the Project. This permanent impact has been carefully evaluated by Metroparks staff and determined to be a "de minimis" impact on Wildwood.

To satisfy requirements of the "Section 4(f) process" as required by applicable federal laws (23 USC §138 and 49 USC §303 and Section 6(f) of 54 USC §200305 (f)), ODOT is required to find and permanently protect suitable replacement parkland to mitigate the loss of parkland that is necessary to complete the Project. As such, ODOT has negotiated the purchase of replacement land from a parcel that adjoins Wildwood that is owned by the Board of Education of the Sylvania City School District. This replacement parcel, totaling 0.068 acres of land is proportional to the permanent impact of the Project.

ODOT has presented a good faith offer of \$4,000.00 consideration to Metroparks for the necessary highway easements as substantiated by a detailed Value Analysis. Additionally, ODOT will agree to acquire and transfer the 0.068-acre replacement parcel to Metroparks and complete all steps necessary to obtain approval of the conversion and replacement of parkland as mandated through the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

I recommend that the board approve the Agreement of Sale with ODOT and authorize Dave Zenk as Executive Director to sign all associated documents necessary to complete the transaction as described above.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation is designing and planning a state highway improvement project identified as LUC 120/Section 11.32, PID 102940, involving the replacement of the Central Avenue Bridge across the Ottawa River (the Project) located adjacent to Wildwood Preserve Metropark (Wildwood), AND,

**WHEREAS**, in order to construct the Project, it is necessary that ODOT acquire an additional right-of-way over a portion of Wildwood adjacent to Central Avenue, including a 0.311-acre permanent highway easement and a 0.006-acre temporary construction easement, AND,

**WHEREAS**, a total of 0.068 acres of parkland within the permanent easement area will be permanently converted for highway purposes as necessary to complete the Project and Metroparks staff has determined the impact on Wildwood to be "de minimis", AND,

WHEREAS, to satisfy requirements of the "Section 4(f) process" as required by 23 USC §138 and 49 USC §303 and Section 6(f) of 54 USC §200305 (f), ODOT is required to find and permanently protect suitable replacement parkland to mitigate the loss of parkland that is necessary to complete the Project, AND,

**WHEREAS**, ODOT has negotiated the purchase of replacement land from a parcel that adjoins Wildwood that is owned by the Board of Education of the Sylvania City School District, with said replacement parcel totaling 0.068 acres of land, AND,

WHEREAS, ODOT has presented a good faith offer of \$4,000.00 consideration to Metroparks for the necessary highway easements as substantiated by a detailed Value Analysis and further agrees to acquire and transfer the 0.068-acre replacement parcel to Metroparks and complete all steps necessary to obtain approval of the conversion and replacement of parkland as mandated through the Land and Water Conservation Fund, NOW, THEREFORE,

### **DESCRIPTION:**

HEAVY @ Oak Openings Beach Ridge Wheelhouse - Microbrewery and Coffeehouse partnership

Metroparks is finalizing a partnership with HEAVY to open a coffee shop/microbrewery concept in the Wheelhouse at Beach Ridge.

The **vision** for this space would be to: enhance the outdoor experiences of mountain biking, trail running, hiking, and camping at the Treehouse Village; be family-friendly; promote an active lifestyle; and connect Oak Openings with other regional destinations, such as the Uptown HEAVY location.

### Our **objectives** include:

- 1. Through joint venture, operate a brewery and coffee shop at the Wheel House that support the park, trail, and treehouse guests
  - a. Enhance the overnight treehouse experience by offering refreshments and a social experience on-site
  - b. Further engage with outdoor recreationalists (specifically, mountain bikers) who desire an opportunity for socializing and refreshments before (snacks) and after (craft brew) recreating
- 2. Create experiences and connections with the region that promote shared values of Heavy and Metroparks, including menu options featuring local ingredients and clever branding
- 3. Be financially prudent
  - a. Generate new income that can be invested in trail improvement and maintenance
  - b. Limit Metroparks financial risk via a renewable one-year lease arrangement (with two annual renewal options), conservative business plan that allows us to recoup construction costs within 1-2 years, and implementing construction improvements that enable us to repurpose the space for future uses as needed

### Key **operational considerations** are:

- Metroparks would enter into a joint venture with HEAVY, and be responsible for a
  permanent improvements to the Wheel House building (such as installing a central drain
  and additional plumbing); as well as ongoing building maintenance
- HEAVY would operate the coffee shop/brewery business from end to end, purchasing all furniture and equipment, and managing all food/drink service and business operations
- Both HEAVY and Metroparks would promote and program the concept to activate it
- The coffee shop/brewery would operate during Treehouse Village open hours
- Offerings would include:
  - Three beers brewed onsite using small holding tanks, featuring local ingredients and grain processed at the Isaac Ludwig Mill
  - Coffee/espresso (hot and cold) service
  - Packaged and fresh snacks (fruit, nut bars), and possible savory snack (stacked toast, flatbread, etc.)
  - o Basic retail offerings

We have been in discussions with Andrew Newby and Kristin Kaiser, owner/operators of Toledo Spirits, Black Kite Coffee, and the newest launch: Heavy Microbrewery. Since 2019, we have together refined the business concept, developed and negotiated a business plan and pro forma, and drafted a lease.

Metroparks has gathered construction quotes for building modifications and has budgeted for the full amount of the project.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Park Commissioners approve the authorization for Metroparks to enter into a lease and joint venture with Heavy to open and operate Heavy @Oaks, a microbrewery/ coffeehouse and for the Executive Director to execute the Lease and such other documents as are necessary to enter into the lease and joint venture arrangement.

Sealed proposals for bidding on the Swan Creek Connector Trail, 4301 Airport Hwy., Toledo, Ohio 43615 were received Friday, July 02, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. Five (5) bids were received with Great Lakes Demolition Company, LLC of Vickery, Ohio, the apparent lowest and best bidder at \$2,869,709.50.

The Scope of Work consists of construction of a 10 foot wide shared use path through Swan Creek Preserve Metropark. The new 10 foot wide path will consist of approximately 2,100 feet of aggregate path, 5,600 feet of asphalt, 580 feet of box beam "boardwalk" plus overlook, 2 steel truss bridges over Swan Creek, piling foundations with concrete caps, and concrete abutments. General construction includes clearing and grubbing; erosion control; storm drainage; aggregate and asphalt pavement; segmental retaining wall; concrete abutments and pier caps; steel pilings; steel truss bridges with concrete deck; box beams with concrete topping; railings. Work is expected to commence fall 2021, with substantial completion anticipated by June 30, 2022.
