1. NON-RESOLUTION BOARD ITEMS

President Scott Savage called the meeting to order at 8:37 a.m.

Mr. Scott Savage led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Savage welcomed the Glass City Metropark staff that were in attendance and proceeded to thank them for all of their hard work that has been completed, and continues to be done, within the park since opening day.

2. CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

Mr. Fritz Byers made a motion for the disposition of the minutes for the regular Board meeting held on August 23, 2023, the Special Board Meeting held on August 29, 2023, and the consent agenda for the meeting on September 27, 2023. This motion was seconded by Mr. Kevin Dalton and approved.

3. CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS FROM DIRECTOR AND EMPLOYEES OF THE PARK DISTRICT FOR REVIEW

A. Rangers in Your Metroparks – Brad Navarre, Chief of Rangers

Mr. Brad Navarre shared an overview of Metroparks Toledo Rangers and all of the work they cover within their roles. He specifically stated that rangers are true Peace Officers and have to go through all of the trainings that all law enforcement has to. In addition to the law enforcement aspect of their role, he shared that rangers are to perform Quality Visitor Interactions (QVI), where they intentionally seek out visitors to interact with and then the interactions are captured to measure the number of encounters that are taking place. It is very important that visitors feel welcomed and these QVIs help bridge that gap.

Mr. Navarre went on to say that the department also incorporates special assignments. Some of these include:

- Detective
- Field Training Officers
- Wellness Therapy Dog Unit this is brand new and the first within Northwest Ohio. The dog will be used for various programming opportunities and will be used by the Public Information Officer in his daily work. These types of dogs are used for law enforcement purposes, such as for any type of interviews especially with children who have been involved in a traumatic situation, the dog will help the victims be calm. Additionally, the dog can dispatched to help with other jurisdictions if needed.

Mr. Navarre concluded that rangers are dedicated employees who are committed to protecting our organization and everything it stands for.

Mr. Byers shared he is deeply moved by the energy and commitment that comes through when hearing about everything that Mr. Navarre and the rangers do. He went to share that as the recipient of the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) Gold Medal award, this is a very proud moment, and underscores our stature as a first in class park district. Mr. Byers went on to state that he has always known that the ranger force is a real example of that. Despite Mr. Navarre's modesty, Mr. Byers stated that Metroparks Toledo has the very best people, including across the ranger department and that being a ranger is an integral part of the workings of the parks. He went to say that Mr. Navarre alluded to keeping our parks safe, and this is consistent with the promises Metroparks Toledo has made to the community, clean – safe - natural, and the parks can't be that unless all of these things are simultaneously happening. Metroparks Toledo is open to everyone to provide an opportunity to engage in nature, and we wouldn't be able to make that promise if the rangers didn't do their work every day Mr. Byers stated that Mr. Navarre mentioned it's a thankless job; however, the Metroparks Toledo Board of Park Commissioners is deeply thankful for all of the work the rangers do for Metroparks Toledo.

Mr. Navarre thanked the Board of Park Commissioners for all of their support.

B. Treasurer's Report – Matt Cleland, CFO/Treasurer

Mr. Matt Cleland stated the really good news this month is that the second half property tax settlement came in strong. The margin within budget for expenses is three percent, which is low. Projections through year end indicate that we will still be within budget.

Mr. Savage asked if we had budgeted for the additional revenue. Mr. Cleland replied, no, we did not.

4. BOARD APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS, DEEDS, AGREEMENTS, ETC.

A. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Molly Luetke:

Resolution No. 61-23 – Approval of Supplement and Amendment of the 2023 Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations Measure

Mr. Cleland described the supplements to the budget for each of the three funds affected.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

B. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Dalton:

Resolution No. 62-23 — Resolution Accepting the 2024 Amounts & Rates as Determined by the Budget Commission & Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying them to the County Auditor

Mr. Cleland stated that this is an annual event where the commissioners approve the rates provided by the County Auditor's office.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

C. Mr. Dalton offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 63-23 – 2024 Request for Advance of Taxes Collected

Mr. Cleland stated that this is an annual event to request the advance payment of collected taxes from the County.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

D. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 64-23 – Ratification of Schedule of Payables

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

E. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Dalton:

Resolution No. 65-23 – Authorization to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for Clean Ohio Conservation Program Funds

Mr. Allen Gallant shared that this is a unique situation by trying to apply for these funds all within the same year. This is our standard yearly resolution, we just happen to be able to apply twice within this calendar year. He went on to state that we should hear by the end of the year.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

F. Mr. Dalton offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 66-23 - Ratification of Land Purchase: 10723 Dorr Street

Ms. Zuri Carter shared that this was the first land acquisition that she received in her new role at Metroparks Toledo. Mr. Savage said it was important to note that of the \$80,000.00 sale price, close to \$70,000.00 came from grant funding.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

G. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 67-23 – Ratification of Land Purchase: 60 South Eber Road

Ms. Carter shared that this was the first closing within her new role. She went on to state that this process is very special in that it's wonderful hearing the story from the seller as it relates to the land.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

H. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Dalton:

Resolution No. 68-23 – Ratification of Land Purchase: 5401 Waterville Swanton Rd

Ms. Carter shared that Clean Ohio funding is part of this land acquisition. She went on to share that she has already received comments from the neighbors regarding how excited they were that Metroparks Toledo will be owning the property. This project will be forming wetland restoration, and will launch next week.

Mr. Byers inquired that after the restoration, what portion will still be wetlands? Ms. Carter shared that none of it will be agriculture, rather a mix of wetlands and uplands, and currently we just have concept plans. The Clean Ohio funds typically want a two year project, so ideally this project should wrap up in 2026. Mr. Byers inquired about the Metroparks Toledo match? Ms. Carter responded that yes, currently there is a match; however, we are in the process of applying for an additional grant that will cover the match and zero dollars will be needed from Metroparks Toledo.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

I. Mr. Dalton offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 69-23 – Authorization to Purchase Customized Playground Equipment for Oak Openings Beach Ridge Area

Ms. Jen Van Horn shared that this playground will be in the grass area near the barn. Mr. Savage would like to see the final master plan once completed.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

J. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 70-23 – Contract Approval, Metroparks Toledo – MLK Multi-Use Path, Toledo, Ohio 43605 -

PID 111525

Ms. Van Horn shared that this will path will be constructed under the MLK Bridge which will connect the two properties on each side of the bridge.

Mr. Byers inquired about the gaps within the bids. Ms. Van Horn responded that the awarded contractor is currently on the ground, and will be using similar subcontractors, which allows for significant cost-savings. Ms. Van Horn and Mr. Jon Zvanovec both shared they are very pleased with the work from this contractor.

Mr. Dave Zenk stated that it's easy to gloss over the significance of this project, but this is really exciting and impactful for the entire Riverwalk project.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

5. BOARD INITIATED TOPICS AND DISCUSSION

Mr. Zenk mentioned that on Friday, September 22, 2023, the City of Toledo welcomed the Deputy Secretary of Agriculture Xochitl Torres Small, who announced the award of RE-TREE Toledo, which is by far and away the most significant forestation award in the entire state. Metroparks Toledo was a sub awardee and will receive about 2,000 trees to help with the Metroparks Toledo in the downtown area. Mr. Gallant shared that we are thrilled to partner with the City of Toledo. He went to state that this is a great example of the collaboration work with the city, and that we communicate regularly to find opportunities to benefit the entire region. With this particular award, Workforce development will receive a portion to encourage kids to engage in this work. Both Metroparks Toledo and the City of Toledo will see the benefit in this over the course of the next 5 years in that this experience could lead these kids to enter into employment with both entities.

With no further business or action to be taken, Mr. Dalton made a motion to adjourn the Board meeting at 9:36 a.m., which was seconded by Ms. Luetke and approved.

1. Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – General Fund as of 09/30/2023

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of the General Fund budgeted revenues, expenditures and transfers compared to actual revenues, expenditures and transfers by month as well as year-end. The approved 2023 general operating fund budget and actual cash basis revenues, expenditures and transfers are represented. Year to date budget distribution is based upon a 12 month proration with the exception of salaries and fringe benefits. Salary and fringe benefit budget distribution is based upon a proration of 26 pay dates. (See Appended Statement – Attachment A).

<u>Current State</u>: General Fund expenses are running higher than expected; however, projections indicate we will finish narrowly within budget.

2. Receipts, Disbursements and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – All Funds as of 09/30/2023

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of annual budgeted receipts and disbursements compared to cash basis actuals as of month end. The General, Education/Programming, and Debt Service funds are presented as individual columns. The Grant Funds, Land Acquisition/Development, Capital Construction and All Other Funds columns are each summaries of multiple funds. The far right column is a total of all funds. General fund budget and actual numbers presented in this report are consistent with those presented in the report listed above. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment B).

<u>Current State</u>: Grant funds revenue and expenses are significantly below budget. The recording of BUILD grant payments from ODOT directly to vendors will close these margins.

3. Fund Advances Report – All Funds as of 09/30/2023

<u>Description</u>: This is a report of inter-fund, Board approved advances activity. Advances are made to support reimbursement grants and activities that would otherwise result in negative fund balances. Advances are returned following the receipt of grant reimbursement revenue.

<u>Description</u>: This report is a listing of the Park District's current investment holdings. Current investments are allowable per the Ohio Revised Code and are laddered over a 5-year period. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment D).

<u>Current State</u>: In September, two certificates of deposits matured and two certificates of deposits were purchased.

7. Then and Now Report for the month ended 09/30/2023

<u>Description</u>: The Ohio Revised Code (ORC) requires fiscal certification indicating that amounts required for purchases, obligations, contracts, etc. have been lawfully appropriated and are in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances. Then and now is a certification by the Board that funds were available when an obligation was made (then) and at the time of certification (now) for obligations made prior to certification. To be eligible for federal LWCF grant assistance, Ohio prepares and updates the Ohio Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP). Ohio reviews LWCF grant applications and submits recommended projects to the National Park Service for final approval. All recommended projects must be in accord with Ohio's SCORP priorities.

Metroparks will be requesting an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 to support Oak Openings Corridor habitat expansion. There is a 1:1 match requirement.


