Fishing Notice

Wiregrass Lake is more than just a place to fish and kayak. It's a home for rare plants, many species of dragonflies, threatened turtles, and native fish. **The south end of the lake is closed to fishing** due to the high number of sensitive species found there. To help maintain a delicate balance at this site, fishing is only permitted from the dock, stone ledges, and edges along the northern section of the lake. Kayaks should only be launched from the dock.
